

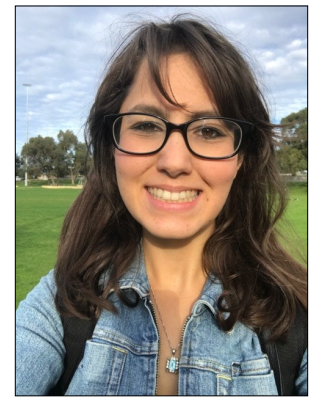
# STANDING UP FOR YOURSELF
