The **do not call register** stops sellers from calling you on the phone.

The law says sellers are not allowed to call you unless you say it is okay.

A **seller** is a person who sells products and services to you.

You can register your home or mobile phone number.

It is free to register.

---



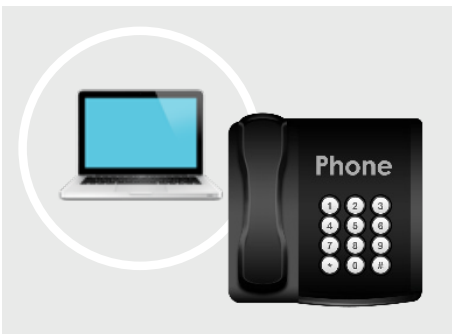
Your number will stay on the Do Not Call Register.

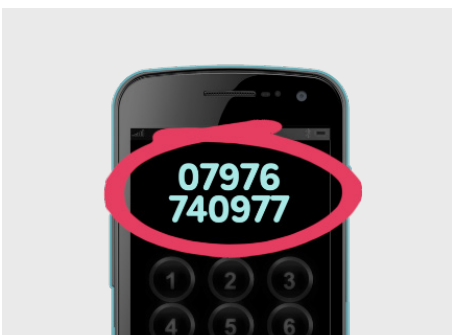
People can still call you such as
